→ PROGRAMMES FOR A EUROPEAN DEGREE

The T4EU partner universities are collaborating during workshops lead by UJM to develop at least 10 new joint programmes by the end of the project in 2027. Workshops focus on designing joint programmes with the goal of obtaining a European label (a European certificate in addition to national diplomas) or a European degree (a new qualification embedded in national legislation).
